Health and Safety Statement

The Manawatu A & P Association is required to conform to the **Health and Safety at Work Act 2015**; therefore, you are required to carry out your work or undertaking on the Manfeild Park premises to comply with this Act. As a show exhibitor at this venue, you are obligated to accept responsibility for ensuring a safe showing venue within the focus of the Act. As a user of these facilities, you are required to manage and supervise all your activities and live animals exhibits to ensure the good Health and Safety of all people involved in the show, at all times.

Health and Safety Specific Requirements

- All vehicles, caravans and floats requiring power **must** have a Warrant of Electrical Fitness that meets legislation standard AS/NZS 3001.
- Any and all electrical equipment, including extension power leads, must be **tested and tagged with a current tag** (Standard AS/NZS3760).
- Anyone wanting power to their pens please let us know. Please be aware there will be a charge of \$250.
- *Vehicles and leads may be checked during the show, on a strictly 'user pays' basis.*
- Anyone bringing in or in charge of the use of any motorized bike, two, three or four wheeled, must be trained in its use and must wear a safety helmet at **ALL** times when using it.
- As Manfeild Park is a public place, bike riders must have a current Drivers' Licence.
- Quad bikes must not carry passengers, and no one under the age of 16 is permitted to operate a quad bike.
- Motorbike riders must **observe a speed limit of 15 km per hour at all times, anywhere on the show grounds.**

Conditions of Entry

1. All Alpacas to be penned by **8.00am Saturday 4th November 2023**. Judging to commence at 8.30am. This show is run under the Rules and Regulations of AANZ.
2. All animals must belong to a clear TB herd where whole herd testing is performed in accordance with the AANZ voluntary TB scheme and either (a) the herd they came from has a current valid (clear) TB whole herd certificate and is situated outside any Declared Movement Control Area for cattle and Deer as defined and mapped by the Animal Health Board or (b) the herd they come from has a current valid (clear) TB whole herd certificate and they are situated within any Declared Movement Control Area for Cattle and Deer as defined and mapped by the Animal health Board and the specified alpacas attending the Show have been tested clear of TB within 60 days of the Show.

All alpacas entered in Championship Classes and Non-Championship Classes must be registered with the IAR and carry a brass ear tag displaying its Corresponding IAR number. Copies of registration certificates do not need to be submitted, just the IAR written clearly on the entry form.

3. All alpacas must be registered by the Show closing date. Pending registrations are not acceptable.
4. The exhibitor is the owner(s) listed on the IAR. In the case of a registered lease, the lessee is deemed the owner.
5. The age of the alpaca is the age on the day of the show.
6. All exhibitors or handlers must place their animals in the pens allotted by the convenor. Placement of animals in "trade/Sales pens" will only be done with the permission of the Chief Steward.
7. No animal or fleece shall be removed from the show prior to the completion of judging (approximately 4.30pm) without the express permission of the Chief Steward.
8. All exhibitors must be a financial AANZ member.
9. If the timetable is revised – all exhibitors will be advised prior to the Show.
10. Entry fees are non-refundable where entries are subsequently withdrawn from competition or exhibitors fail to attend the show.
11. Animals are to be entered in the correct class for the colour of the animal, not necessary the colour shown on the IAR certificate. Colour checks can be requested at the time of registration on show day. See the Chief Steward if you have any doubts about the specific colour class of your animals.
12. Dress Code for our show is black trousers/skirt and white shirt/blouse or AANZ shirt and preferably black shoes – not gumboots! Having all exhibitors dressed neatly in a similar attire makes for a professional image to the public. In accordance with S15 Show Regulations D6 – Handlers Attire (b) "No alpaca related logos are permitted on handlers clothing with the exception of the AANZ logo".
