Canterbury A & P Assn Show has been saved this year by Event Hire who have undertaken to run the Entertainment, Trade and Food areas on Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

All livestock sections will be running only on Thursday and Friday this year. Some of the sections have cut their classes back to fit into the two days.

The Wool Section has opted to run this year with their display in a marquee along Deans Avenue between the alpaca ring and the Shearing Pavilion.

Some notes to help you navigate through the on-line system:


Remember to tick the box at the end of reading the "Section Notes" otherwise you will not be able to proceed Enter n/a under bank account.

Payment – tick the "Already Paid" box at the top of the payment list IF YOU HAVE PAID YOUR MEMBERHSIP FEES EARLIER THIS YEAR


You will be offered payment via Credit Card or POLI.

If you are currently not a member - consider joining and supporting CAPA (\$90 single membership per year). I have test run the system and it is working really well. Because it is a new system from last year you will need a new username and password.

When entering multiple animals/fleeces – please see below instructions: Once you have entered one fleece/animal then hit "add another entrant"



You will need to select your name and exhibit type (alpacas are under farm animals) then hit "select classes", then go into the Alpacas and carry on entering as many fleeces/animals that you need to.



Our judge this year for both fleece and breed is Ariana McCauley from NSW

Breed and Fleece classes have been cut back to four classes:

Junior 6-12 months, Intermediate 12-24 months, Adult 24-36 months and Senior 36 months and over

There will be no Champion Male or Female in the breed classes

Entry fees for fleeces have increased to \$15 per entry (\$20 for non-members)

Entry fees for breed remain the same at \$10 per entry (\$20 for non-members)

Prize Money has been halved to \$50.00 for each Fleece and Breed Supreme Champion

We are hoping for a great show of support from alpaca exhibitors. Across the show all supporters and committee members are all volunteers, and we have been working hard to bring the show together.

Can we please have the following help for the alpaca section please:

BEFORE THE SHOW:

Saturday, 9 November: Several people to help Bevan put up the two alpaca marquhees Wednesday, 13 November (afternoon): Several people to help with the set up of the fleece display

SHOW DAY: One ring steward

Help to take the marquees down after the show

Penning:

- For those leaving alpacas in the Cattle Pavilion on Wednesday night before the show there is no security paid for by the show this year the Cattle Committee are asking for an alpaca person to do our part of the night roster: 6 pm to 10 pm. This means keeping an eye on the alpacas and the cattle, if there is a cattle problem they will be in the camping ground reachable by cell phone and instantly on site (no-one is allowed to sleep in the pavilion itself). From 10 pm there will be cattle people in the cattle and alpaca area patrolling the pavilion all night and will have their own roster to ensure the pavilion will be manned.
- For those leaving their alpacas in the cattle pavilion either overnight or during Thursday please remember to pay on your entry forms AND ALSO BRING A WHEELBARROW AND BROOM TO SWEEP OUT YOUR PENS AND TAKE YOUR WASTE DOWN TO THE END OF THE PAVILLION. The Pavilion costs us \$20,000 to clean after each show and we cannot afford that this year, so everyone needs to literally "muck in" and help. For those that cannot fit a wheelbarrow into your float, there will be a couple of barrows and shovels available for your use.
- Please use straw sparingly and don't split a bale until checking to see if there is one already open.
- There will be plenty of room for everyone to bring their own outside pens . If you can take your own outside pens please do so.
- IF YOU CANNOT SUPPLY YOUR OWN OUTSIDE PENS PLEASE LET ME KNOW ASAP so that I can calculate the number of pens that will need to be hired.

Parking:

Still unknown at this stage, I have applied for space directly behind the cattle pavilion – details to be sent out prior to the Show

Supreme Animal in Show: Will be judged this year and we require the Alpaca for this award to come back to the showgrounds on the Friday afternoon if possible.

Prize money:

• This year the prize money of \$100 to each Supreme winner will be reduced to \$50.00 (please note this amendment will not show on the schedule).
