# Non – Championship Classes

The following classes are to be entered on the day of the show – the, sire/dam name and the names of his/her progeny are to be registered with the Chief Steward before the commencement of the judging of the Progeny Classes.

### Entry Fee \$0

- Get of Dam (Suri) This class is for the exhibiting of the progeny from the same dam. The dam is not shown. Progeny are shown in groups of two and can be of mixed sex, age and colour but must have been shown in their respective *Championship* classes at the same show. Progeny can be owned by different exhibitors.
- 504 Get of Dam (Huacaya) details as above
- Sires Progeny (Suri) This class is for the exhibiting of progeny from the same sire. The sire is not shown. Progeny are shown in groups of two and can be of mixed sex, age and colour but must have been shown in their respective *Championship* classes at the same show. Progeny can be owned by different exhibitors.
- 506 Sires Progeny (Huacaya) details as above

The following classes can be entered on the day of the show – these classes will be judged by a guest judge during the lunch break.

### Entry Fee \$0\*\*\*.

- Novice 5 + year olds who don't have regular contact with alpacas. Judged on ability to manoeuvre an alpaca over a course of obstacles and follow instructions.
- 508 Child 5 to 10 year olds who have regular contact with alpacas. This class will be judged on handling ability, basic alpaca knowledge and ability to manoeuvre an alpaca over a simple course of obstacles.
- Junior 11 + year olds who have regular contact with alpacas. This class will be judged on handling ability, alpaca knowledge and ability to manoeuvre an alpaca over a complex course of obstacles.

\*\*\* Alpacas not entered in the breed show but being brought to the show for the handler classes must be entered on the Breed Entry Form and include a current Tb certificate. A pen fee of \$10 will apply.

## This show is run under the Rules and Regulations of AANZ Conditions of Entry:

- 1. All animals must belong to a clear TB herd where whole herd testing is performed in accordance with the AANZ voluntary TB scheme. Copies of current TB certificates are required by the Rotorua A & P.
- 2. All alpacas entered in Championship Classes must be registered with the IAR and carry a brass ear tag displaying its corresponding IAR number. Copies of registration certificates are **not** required to be enclosed with the entry forms.
- 3. The exhibitor is the owner(s) listed on the alpaca's registration certificate. In the case of a registered lease, the lessee is deemed the owner.
- 4. The age of the alpaca is its age on the day of the show.
- 5. All exhibitors or handlers must place their animals in the pens allotted by the Convenor. Placement of animals in 'trade pens' will only be done with the permission of the Chief Steward.
- 6. No animal shall be removed from the show prior to the completion of the judging without the permission of the Chief Steward.
